Parks & Recreation Advisory Committee (PRAC)'s Updated Priorities as of May, 2022

After a special meeting held on 05/23/2022, The Parks & Recreations Advisory Committee (PRAC) of Weldon Spring reestablished their priorities for the remainder of Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 and into FY 2023. This was work was requested by the Board of Aldermen at their first official May meeting. The PRAC worked from the *Parks Fund Five Year Planning Worksheet – FC PARC Updated 08-10-2021* Document (Attached). The PRAC only established priorities for the remainder of FY 2023 and FY 2023 because of the expected City-wide Parks & Green Way Master Plan (CPGMP) adoption in the coming weeks. The PRAC will update the rest of the five-year priorities after the CPGMP is adopted. Below is a synopsis of the recommended priorities for the remainder of FY 2023.
